If a registered voter expects to be absent from the County on the date of election or is physically incapacitated, they may cut out, complete and return the application form to the County Clerk's office and will receive an absentee ballot for the Nov. 2, 1976 General Election. The back of the application form must be completed, with the signature of the attending Physician, for the physically incapacitated to receive their absentee ballot.

October 28, 1976 is the last day to apply by mail for an absentee ballot. If you are applying for an absentee ballot, complete the application form and return it to the County Clerk's office at once.

Absentee voting in person will be accepted at the County Clerk's office through Monday, November 1, 1976.

I hereby make application for an official ballot or ballots to be voted by me at such election for the above stated reason, and I agree to return such ballot or ballots to the official issuing the same in sufficient time for such official to deliver such ballots to the proper polling place prior to the closing of the polls on the day of the election.
