INSTRUCTIONS ON THE CASTING OF VOTES

1. Approach the chairman of the board and give your name, address and other personal circumstances concerning your person.
2. The board shall check your name in the Voters' List.
3. The chairman shall announce your name loud enough to be heard inside the polling place.
4. If no one challenges you, you will be asked to affix your signature at the back of your Voter Registration Record (VRR).
5. The chairman shall enter the serial number of your ballot in your VRR and sign at the back of the ballot.
6. Upon receiving your ballot correctly folded by the chairman, proceed to a vacant voting booth and write in the proper space for each office the names of the candidates you want to vote for.
7. After filling the ballot, fold it in the same manner as when you received it, and return it to the chairman.
8. The chairman shall check if the serial number of your ballot tallies with the one entered in your VRR. If it tallies, you will be asked to affix your thumbmark in the corresponding spaces in the ballot and in your VRR. Indelible ink shall then be applied on your right forefinger.
9. The chairman shall sign in the VRR, detach the coupon of your ballot in your presence, deposit the folded ballot in the compartment for valid ballots and the detached coupon in the compartment for spoiled ballots.
10. You may now leave the polling place.
