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

PROCEDURES SEPARATING BALLOT STUB(S) FROM OFFICIAL BALLOT(S)

- (1) Turn "white label" on secrecy envelope facing you with arrow pointing up.
- (2) Place thumb of left hand over round hole in secrecy envelope.
- (3) Place middle finger of left hand over hole on opposite side of secrecy envelope.
- (4) Place index finger of left hand on lip of secrecy envelope and grip ballot(s) snugly.
- (5) Ask voter if they placed all stub(s) at top of secrecy envelope and verify that all stubs are at top of secrecy envelope.
- (6) Bend stub(s) back and forth with right hand to breakdown perforation so stub(s) separate clean and easy. At the same time ask the voter:
 - (A) Have you finished voting?
 - (B) Did you "Vote Both Sides" of ballot? (Ask this question only when ballot information appears on both sides of ballot.)
- (7) Holding secrecy envelope in left hand horizontal to floor with your elbows up, grip stub(s) at top right corner and pull.

NOTE: Above procedures written for "RIGHT" handed Election Board Workers.



WRITE-IN PROCEDURES FOR GENERAL ELECTIONS

*** DATAVOTE PUNCHCARDS ***

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS:

TO VOTE FOR A WRITE-IN CANDIDATE, WRITE THE NAME OF THE CANDIDATE IN THE BLANK SPACE PROVIDED AND PUNCH OUT THE CROSS IN THE VOTING SQUARE TO THE RIGHT OF THE CANDIDATE'S NAME.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANVASSING WRITE-IN VOTES:

- A. After polls close, ballots are to be examined for write-in votes. Any card containing a write-in vote is to be placed in a separate stack.
- B. Place all Official Ballot cards NOT containing write-in votes into the Ballot Transfer Case.
- C. Check WRITE-IN BALLOT ENVELOPE and make sure PRECINCT NUMBER has been entered.
- D. Count ballot cards containing write-in votes and enter the TOTAL NUMBER CARDS ENCLOSED on the line provided on the Write-In Ballot Envelope.
- E. If there are $\underline{\text{NO}}$ write-in ballots, write $\underline{\text{NONE}}$ on the Write-In Ballot Envelope on the line provided for TOTAL NUMBER CARDS ENCLOSED.
- F. Place all cards containing write-in votes into the WRITE-IN BALLOT ENVELOPE.
- G. Place the WRITE-IN BALLOT ENVELOPE in the Ballot Transfer Case on top of the Official Ballots.
- H. Place "White Copy" of Ballot Accounting Form on top of Write-In Ballot Envelope.
