REQUIREMENTS TO REGISTER TO VOTE

You may register to vote if you are:

- 1) A U.S. citizen and a legal resident of Florida.
- 2) Eighteen years of age (you can pre-register during your 17th year. A voter identification card will be sent to you when you turn 18).

SELECTING A PARTY

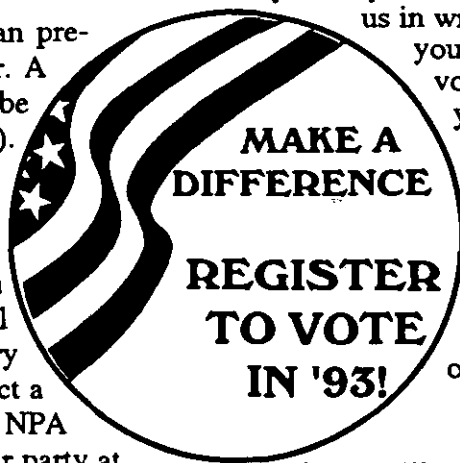
Florida has two major parties-Democrat & Republican. If you select one of these parties, you will be permitted to vote in party primary elections. If you choose not to select a party at this time, you may register as NPA (No Party Affiliation) and select your party at a later date by informing our office in writing. You may also register as any of the minor political parties. Registering as an NPA or minor party does not permit you to vote in primary elections. Party affiliation makes no difference in a general election when you may vote for any candidate regardless of his/her party affiliation.

CHANGING YOUR NAME, ADDRESS, PARTY AFFILIATION, OR REPLACING A LOST CARD

If you change your name, address or party affiliation you may either come into one of our offices or notify us in writing and a new card will be mailed to you. There is a section on the back of your voter identification card for you to change your address and mail it to us. If you move out of Broward County and register elsewhere, your registration in Broward County will be cancelled and you will be required to re-register if you move back. To request a replacement voter identification card you may telephone, visit one of our offices, or make your request in writing.

ABSENTEE VOTING

If you will be out of your precinct on election day, you may vote by absentee ballot. You may request an absentee ballot in person, by phone or by mail at any time prior to each election. Instructions as to the procedures to be followed in voting absentee will accompany the ballot sent to you. Please call 357-7050 for more information regarding absentee voting.
