VOTING INFORMATION

POLLS ARE OPEN FROM 6 A.M. TO 7 P.M. FOR ALL ELECTIONS

You are eligible to register to vote if you are:

- A citizen of the United States
- At least 18 years of age or will be by the next general election
- A resident of Virginia

Voter Registration

- WHERE:**
1. By mail
 2. At Department of Motor Vehicles Offices
 3. At public assistance agencies, i.e., those giving food stamps, aid to dependent children, aid to persons with disabilities, etc.
 4. At military recruitment offices

For other locations and for more information contact your General Registrar.

WHEN: You may register year-round except during the 29 days prior to a general or primary election or the 13 days prior to a special election. Registration will be permanent under most circumstances.

IF YOU MOVE: Contact your General Registrar for further information on transferring your registration.

Absentee Voting

Any registered voter who expects to be away or otherwise physically unable to go to the polls on election day, may request an absentee ballot.

BY MAIL: Application forms may be requested from the General Registrar's Office beginning ten months before the general election and are also available at registration sites and government centers. Mail applications must be received by the General Registrar at least **FIVE DAYS** before an election. **Voted ballots must be received in the office by 7 p.m. Election Day to be counted.**

IN PERSON: Registered voters may apply for and vote an absentee ballot in person at the Registrar's Office beginning 45 days before an election. In Fairfax County, satellite locations are available before general elections. In-person absentee votes may be cast through the Saturday before each election day.
