space.

A.M. returns will be released at about 8:20, shortly after the polls close.

Cumulative totals reflecting P.M. returns will be reported in periodic

intervals after ballot boxes from the polling places begin to arrive at the

District Building. Expect to see the first evening returns at about 10:00 p.m.

Please note that ballot tabulation on November 8th will take longer than it

does for other elections because of the large number of ballots (high voter

turnout and two-card ballots for each voter) and because of the many contests

on the ballot (a total of 333 offices from U.S. President to Advisory

Neighborhood Commissioner—more than 450 candidates). We recommend that you

allow for additional tabulation time when planning your coverage.

ARRANGEMENTS FOR TELEPHONE INSTALLATION in Rooms 501 and 503 may be made with Mrs. Henrietta Lockett at C&P (783-9900). Mrs. Lockett has informed us that all requests for phone installation must be made by November 1st.
