CANDIDATES PRELIMINARILY QUALIFIED FOR OFFICES ON NOVEMBER 8TH BALLOT

The candidates listed below have been determined preliminarily qualified for several offices on the November 8th General Election Ballot. Beginning September 3, 1988 petitions of these candidates will be posted for ten consecutive days, during which any registered voter may challenge the signatures on the petition forms. Filing deadlines for other offices on the November ballot differ and are noted separately.

Independent and minor party candidates for D.C. Delegate to the U.S. House of Representatives and for City Council offices qualify directly for the general election ballot and will be listed along with major party nominees chosen through the primary election process. The primary for Delegate to the House was held May 3, 1988; the primary for City Council will be held September 13th.

Board of Education offices are nonpartisan and do not require a primary; candidates for these offices appear on the general election ballot directly through the submission of signatures.
