This ruling annulled the KPU announcement of May 5, 2004, which stated that the vote results for Golkar in North Aceh VI was 8.954 and for Muaro Jambi II was 10,668. The Court explained that there was strong evidence that counting errors had occurred in North Aceh VI and Muaro Jambi II areas. The correct results for Golkar should have been 10,393 for North Aceh VI, and 11,199 for Muaro Jambi II. With the amended results, Golkar won an additional seat in the Regency DPRDs in North Aceh and Muaro Jambi.

<p>NOTE FOR Golkar: The Substitute Registrar stated that the number of cases filed by Golkar was 13 cases, however there were a lot of sub-cases in their documents, thus the court decided to separate them, resulting in 27 rulings. Out of 27 cases, two challenges were granted, 15 were dismissed, and the rest rejected. The Court stated: "Golkar is the party with the largest number of cases relating to voting results. Out of the 12 cases originally filed, we found 15 sub-cases, thus the total number of cases went up to 27. Other parties which filed a large number of cases included Partai Keadilan Sejahtera (PKS) - 24 cases, Partai Persatuan Pembangunan (PPP) - 22 cases, and Partai Amanat Nasional (PAN) - 20 cases. Even though the number of cases registered in the Constitutional Court was 266, the sub-cases brought the number up to 281 cases"</p>

However, PPDK submitted its case beyond the 3 X 24 hour time limit as stipulated in Law No. 24/2003, thus the case was dismissed.
