AN ACT TO PROTDE FOR THE ELRCTIOI OF THL HEYBEPS OF NRTIOMLI ESSENBLY

## preamble

Finereas it is expedient to bake Provisions for the election of tide hienbers of the liational Asserbly;
 consent of the Council of hinisters, bade this lact pursuant to article $i 29$ of the Constitution of the Ringion of liepal, 204?.

## CHAPTER - I Preliminayy

1. Short Title and commencement :
(1) This kct vaj be cited as "National kssembly Heniers Election 1ct, 2048".
(2) This act shall cone into force imediately.
2. Definitions:

Einless repugnant to the subject or contert, in this kct, --
(a) "Constitution" means constitution of the Kingion of Hepal, 2047.
(b) "Comission" means the Election Comission as mentioned article 103 of the constitation.
(c) "Election" peans the election to be beld to elect Heabers of the Hational bssenbly is accordance with Sub-clauses (b) and (c) of ciause (1) of article 46 of the constitution.
(d) "Foter" peans the Mewors of the Bouse of Representatives.
(e). "Meaber" peans the Hember of the Kational Assembly elected or to be elected pursuant to the prorisions of this let.
(f) "Eeturning Officer" mans the keturning officer appointed under Section 3.
(G) "prescribed" or "as preswibed" neans prescribed or as preswibed in the order issued b; the Comission published in the Nepal Garette.

## CHRPTER - II

Returning Officer, Voters' List and Election Notice
3. Appointment of Returning officer:
(1) The Comission shall conduct the election of the heaber of fational asseably in accordance with the Constitution and the comission shall appoint the yeturning officer for the purpose of the election.
(2) The Returning officer, appointed pursuant to Sub-section (1), shall appoint requisite employees for purpose of the election.
4. Preparation of Voters' List:
[1) The Returning officer shall prepare, in the cannor detercined b: the comission, different roters' list for each of the folio:ing election -.
(a) Election to be held for three wowen liesbers among thirty five Mecbers as provided in Subrclause (b) of Clause (1) of article 46 of the Constitution;
(b) Election to be beld for other thirty two Meabers, excepting those profided in Clause (a) above;
(c) Election to be held for each three leabers representing each Developnent Region as proiided in Sub-clause (c) of Clause (1) of article 46 of the constitution.
(2) The Returning officer shall publish the roters' list prepared pursuant to subsection (1) in his office.

## 5. Notice and Program of Election :

(1) The Comission shall fir the date and tive for election to be beld to elect the Nembers of the National asseably and issue a notice to such effect. Such notification sball be pablished in the llopal Gazette.
(2) Ifter the publication of notice according to Sub-section (1), the Returning office: shall fir the date, tipe and place and publish the election progran for the purposes of filing of nonination papers, publication of the list of candidates shose nonination papers have been filed, raising objection to the nonination of any candidate, scrutiny of the nonination papers, publication of the list of duly norinated candidates, withdraxal of nare by any candidate, publication of final list of the candidates.

## CHAPTER - III

Candidates and Their Nomination
6. Nomination of Candidates:
(1) Each voters shall be entitled to nosinate, in respect of each of the followion elections, one person ato is not disqualified pursuant to Section 7 , as a candidate --
(a) Election to be beld for thirt: two Meabers;
(b) Ilection to be beld for three women Menbers;
(c) Election to be held for eatt three Meabers fror each Developent keqion.
$12 i$ an: parson proposed as a candidate for the election to be held pursuant to Clause (c) of Sub-section 11i, shall bave perranentl; resided in the concerned Deielopnent kegion.
(3) $\quad$.n: candidate proposed pursuant to Sub-section (1! shall have been seconded b; at least three voters.
 not be the proposer or seconder of another candidate.
(5) mile proposing a candidate pursuant to Sub-section (1), a nonination paper, in the format as deterained $b_{i}$ the comission shall be dul; filled in and subaitted at such place and within suct tipe as wa; be specified $b_{j}$ the Returning Officer. Such nonination paper shall mandatoril: contain the siọnatures of the proposer, the seconder and the candidate.
7. Disqualification of a candidate :
(1) The folloiing person shall not be qualified to be a candidate in the election --
(a) - no bo has not completed the age of thirt; five;
(b) iblo is not a citizen of Repal;
ici ino is pentally retarded or insane;
(d) ino is an insolvent;
(e) ano is an eaployee of His Majest;'s Goüernnent, or of a corporate bodij ouned or controlled $b_{j}$ His Majesty's Gorernnent;
if) abo is bolding an office of profit;
Eyplanation: For the purposes of this Clause, the tern "office of profit" veans and includes a position, other than political position to be filled by election or nooination, of which the salary or remneration is paid out of the governoent treasury.
(g) Who is coniicted and sentenced with imprisonoent on an offence relating to election by the Election Iribunal constituted under an existing lav and a period of sir years has not elapsed fron the date of completion of such sentence;
(b) Tho has been convicted in a crininal offence of the nature involiring moral turpitude and sentenced for a tern exceeding two years and a period of siz years bas not elapsed fron the date of completion of such sentence.
(2i) The disqualification as stipulated in Clause (b) of Sur-section (1) shall not be applicable in respect of the first election to be beld after the comencenent of this ect.
(3i bri: person who has been con:icted in an; offence aoganst state or who has been pardoned on political ground as included in a notice published in the Hepal Gasette shal! not be derned as disoualified for the purposes of Clause ib) of Sub-section (1i.
8. Computation of Age of the Candidate :

For the purposes of conputing the age of a candidate, he shall have conpleted the age of thirty five years on the date of publication of election notice pursuant to section 5 .
9. Filing of Nomination Papers :
(1) The nonination paper of a candidate shall be suboitted either b; the candidate tinself or b; his proposer to the Returning officer.
(2) The Returning Officer shall scrutinize all noaination papers as to the completion of formalities, and, if found coapleted, be shall register it and issue a recsipt thereof to the candidate or his proposer.
(3) If any nonination paper filed pursuant to Sub-section (1) is found deficient of anj forealit;, the Returning officer shall require to complete such formalities prior to the reqistration thereof. If the person subritting such nonination paper still insists on filing thereof vithout completing the reguired formalities, such refusal sball be noted on the concerned nonimation paper and the infornation thereof sball be given to the person filing such noxination paper.
10. List of the Candidates :
(1) The Returning officer shall, after the expiry of tine specified for filing of noxination papers, publish the list of candidates filing nouination papers on the date, tipe and place as specified in the election prograd.
(2) If any voter or candidate intends to file an objection against any candidate nentioned in the list published pursuant to Sub-section (1), he vay file his objection with, the Returning Officer on the date, tire and place as specified in the election progran.
11. Scrutiny of Nomination Papers :
(1) The nonination papers shall be scrutinized on the date and tive and at the place notified in the election progran for scruting of nonination papers. The proposer and the candidate may personally attend at such place and tive of scrutiny.
(2) The Returning officer shall scrutinite all nonination papers, mentioned in Subsection (1), in the presence of the candidates and proposers, whe are present therein.
(3) The Returning officer shall, during the scrutinj of nonination papers, probe on the objections, if any, filed pursuant to Sub-section (2) of Section 10, and decide thereupon.

Provided that ninor discrepancies in the nonination papers shall not render then intalid.

Explanation : For the purposes of this Sub-section, "rinor discrepanci" peans the teibnical kistakes relating to the letters, numbers and vovel sians in writing or printing and shere suat nistakes do not cause anj naterial difference.
12. Conditions for Invalidation of Nomination papers : 11 The Returning officer way declare anj nocination paper on any of the follozing circurstances --
(a) If the candidate is disqualified according to this ket;
(b) If the candidate does not consent to or the sicpature of the candidate, proposer ox seconder is nissing or the sigmature contained therein does not appear as genuine;
ic) If the nonination paper is not filed within the tire specified in Section 5 ;
(d) If the nonination paper is not filed complying with the conditions prescribed in Section 9; or
(e) If other conditions prescribed in this kct is not fulfilled.
(21) Whore the Returning officer declares anj nonination paper as invalid pursuant to Sulv-section (1), be shall note the reasons thereof in the nonination paper and shall inforn the concerned candidate.

## 13. List of the Candidates :

The leturning Oificer shall, after the completion of scrutiny of the nonination papers, $:$ prepare a list of the candidates whose nonination papers are found to be in order as required by lai and shall publish a copy thereof in his office.
14. Withdrawal from Candidacy:
(1) If anj candidate desires to withdran his name from the list of candidates, he nay so withdrai his name $b_{i}$ giring a notice in writing to the Returning officer vithin the tine prescribed pursuant to section 5.
(2) L notice for withdraral of nave once subnitted to the Retuming office: shall not be allowed to be cancelled or withdram.
(3) If the Returning Officer is satisfied about the genuineness of the notice subnitted pursuant to Sub-section (1) above, he shall remove the nave of the vithdrawing candidate fror the list of the candidates. The Returning Officer shall imediately publish a notice thereof in his Office.
15. Final List of the candidates :
(1) The Returning officer shall, after the expiny of tire specified in Section 14 for Withdraial of nane, prepare a final list ce the remaining candidates and shall ineodiately publish a copy of the list in his office.
(2) In the list prepared pursuant to Sub-section (1), the napes of the candidates shall appear in alphabetical order and the address of the candidates, as mentioned in the nosination paper, shall also appear therein.
16. Declaration as Elected Uncontested :
11) If the number of candidates to be elested is equal to or less than the mabor of Heabers to be elected, the Retaming officer shall declare such candiontes elected unopposed.
(2) Where the cendidate is declared elected unopposed prizsuant to Sut-section 12i, the Returning officer shall infors it to the comission.
17. Identity Card of the Candidate :

The keturning Officer shall issue identity cards to the candidates rebaining in the final list of candidates as prepared pursuant to Section 15.
18. Death of a Candidate :
il) If anj candidate dies at anj time after the publication of final list of candidates pursuant to Section 15 and earlier to the daj preceding the polling date and a sritten information is received relating thereto by the Returning officer, and if the Returning officar is satisfied, he shall imediately suspend the polling prograr and shall, as soon as practicable, give information relating thereto to the comission. : notice of suspension of procran shall be served by the Returning officer in his office for information of the revaining candidates.
(2i The Comsission, on receipt of inforaation pursuant to Sul-section (1) above, shall re-schedule the election progran including tipe polling date and commicate it to the Yeturning Officer.
(3). The candidates whose nape appear in the final list published pursuant to Section 15 shall not be required to file their norination paper agaic.
provided that any person who had vithdrain prior to the suspension of polling shall -be entitled to re-subnit his nogination paper as a candidate.

CHAPTER - IV
Ballot Papex, Ballot Box and polling
19. Ballot Paper :
(1) Fre design of the Ballot Paper sball be as preseribed b; the Comission.
(2) The Returning officer shall band out the Ballot Paper to time roter, who is present at the polling station.
20. Ballot Box :

For the purposes of polling, the Ballot Bor as provided $b_{j}$ the Comission shall be used.
21. Polling Method :
(1) Each voter shall confidentially cast his vote by indicating in the ballot paper his preference in the manner as specified in Sub-section (2) below.
(2) While casting his vote, the voter shall indicate bis first preference rote by writing the number 1 at the blank space provided for indicating the preference against the nane of the candidate to whon be intends to give his first preference. Ifter indicating the first preference in the manner aforesaid, be way, if be vishes, vote with other preferences by witing numbers 2, 3, 4, etc. at other blank spaces against the nane of such other candidates.

Provided that while indicating suah other preferences, no preference shall be indicated which sould be in eycess of the number of candidates to be eleated.
(3) Ho one vay poll $b_{j}$ indicating the same number of preference to nore than one person.
22. Adjournment of polling During Emergency :
(1) If the Rearning officer is satisfied that the polling cannot be continued oue to the existence of circunstances beyond his control, be nay inpediately suspend the polling and shall publish therein a notice to that effect.
(2) Where the polling is suspended pursuant to Sub-section (1), the Returning officer shall imediately infors the comission in respect thereof.
(3) Where the polling has been suspended pursuant to Sub-section (2), the Returning Officer shall re-schedule the polling date and tive and publish a notice to this effect and conduct the re-polling.
23. Entry to polling Station:

The keturning officar shall prohibit entry to the polling station of all porsons excapt the following --
(a) Voters,
(b) Candidates,
(c) Persons authorised b; the Comission or keturning officer.
(2i) - Yo roter shall be pergitted to enter the polling station after the expiry of tise allocated for polling.
24. Inspection by the Returning officer : If the keturning officer suspects of anj pischief being comitted within the place secluded for marking rotes, be way enter such place and inspect therein.
25. Incapacitated Voter :
(1) If any voter being umable to cast his rote bj binself for the reason of his physical infiraity requests for the peraission of accompanying a person of his confidence with hin, the Returning officer nay pernit the entr; of such person to accorpany the voter upto the place of earking the votes.
(2) If any roter cannot himself mart his rote and reguests the returning Officer to oart in the balliot paper at the blank space provided for indicating the preference against the name of the candidate to who be intends to give his first preference, the Returning Officer may assist hir in arking his vote according to the rist of such roter.

## CHAPTER - V <br> Counting of Votes and Election Result

26. Notice on Vote counting :
ifter the coupletior of polling, the Returning officer stall poblish a notice at his office inforxing the candidates abort the place, date and tive fixed for the counting of rotes.
27. Counting of Votes :
(1) The keturning officer shall comonne counting of votes in the place and on the date and tive fired in the notice published pursuant to section 26.
(2) Tpe candidates and otbar persons perritied b; the keturning officer va; attend at the place of counting of votes.
(3) The keturning Officer nay order any person obstructing the counting of votes to leave the place stere the rotes are being coumted and the persor so ordered shall be under
obligation to leave such place. If the person so ordered does not conpl; aith such order, the securit; personnel shail, upon the order of the returninc Officer, ezpel the concerned person fror such place with the use of force, if necessar;.
28. Vote Counting to be continuous :
(1) Once the counting of votes is comenced, the process thereof shall be kept continuous until conpleted.
(2) If for anj reason the process of counting of rotes cannot be continued and has to be adjourned, the Returning officer sball prepare a list of the counted ballot papers, records relating to the comting and the renaining ballot papers to be counted and sball keep then in separate enielopes and seal such envelopes with sealing war. The candidates, if thei; wish, na; also bave their seal with the sealing wai.
(3i The counting of rotes, se adjouned accordinc to Sub-section i2i above, shall be resumed as earlj as possible.
29. Invalidity of Ball ot Papers : The following ballot papers shall be deeped in:alid --
(a) If it does not bear the sionature of the Returning officer;
(b) If it is barked in an; othor nanner in stead of narking in the uanner prescribed b; this ect;
(c) It the ballot paper is nutilated or blurred or dofaced bejond identification of the vote;

(e) If the mark is unclear as to which candidate the vote is intended;
(f) If it is a fake ballot paper;
(g) If no first preference is indicated;
(b) If the first preference is indicated to nore than one candidate;
(i) : If bore than one preference is indicated to a candidate;
iji If no identification is possible as to whon the first preference is indicated.
30. Separation of Invalid Ballot papers :

The Returning officer shall scrutinize all ballot papers and separate all ballot papers deemed invalid pursuant to Section 29. He shall denote the reasons of inialidit: on the reverse side of each of such ballot paper and shall place all such inialid ballot papers within an envelope and seal it.
31. Minimum Number of Votes required to be Elected : winle deterrining the niniar numbers of votes required to be elected, the following process should be adopted --
(a) To multipl: the nupber of valid ballot papers $b_{;}$; 10\%,
(b) To add bj 1 number to the total nmber of henipers to be elected,
(c) Fo diride the qultiplied figure amived under Clause ial $b_{j}$ the number arrived under Clause (b),
id) To add again bje 1 number to the diridend resulting fron the di:isios nade according to Clause (c).
32. Other procedures Relating to the Counting of Votes : othar procedures relating to the counting of votes shall be as laid doin b; the comission. Such procedures shall be published in the Nepal Gaseate.
33. Publication of Election Result :
(1) : Opon completion of the counting of votes, the Retuming officer shall prepare a result sheet of counting of rotes and shall publish the election result. He shall forward a copy of such result sheet to the Comission.
(2) The Returning Officor, after the publication of the election result, prepare a detailed report containing other relevant facts abort the election, and send it as soon as possible to the comrission.
(3) The Comission shall, upon receipt of the result sbeet of the election pursuant to Suh-section (1), prepare a list of the elected heabers and formard it to the Secretariat of the Parliament. The Comsission shall also publish suab list in the Hepal Gazette.

## CHAPTER - VI <br> Miscellaneous

34. Termination of Kembership:
(1) If tbe election of anj Henber is annulled pursuant to the decision of the Election Iribunal constituted under the Election (Offences and Pumishnent) bet, 2047, the Kenbership of such Menber shall terninate with effect fron the date of such decision.
(2) If anj Henber is elected as a Honber of the Bouse of Representatives, his Heabership shall terninate jpso facte with effect fron the date of being so elected.
35. Maintenance of Secrecy :
(1) Onless authorised by lai, no explojee deputed in election duti; or candidate or anj other person shall disclose orally or in uriting or in anj other manner, the vote as indicated $\mathrm{bj}_{\mathrm{j}}$ the voter in the ballot paper or anj other inforsation relating thereto knoinn to hin or sithin his knocledge.
(2) Hotwithstanding anjtbing contained in this let or in $a n$; other existing laik, no sitness or an: other person shall be asked, in any legal proceeding comenced under this act, any question pertaining to boii and to whor be o: any other person bas roted.
36. Secrecy of pocuments Relating to Election :

11 lbonc the election docuents, onl; such doments wich are required for counting of votes maj; be opened for suct purposes and the; sball be re-sealed after the counting is
cospleted. All such docurents shall be kept ir: custod; of the officor designated b: the Comission.
(2) Among the docunents sealed and preserved pursuant to Sub-section (1), suct envelopes containing the ballot papers, voters' list used during the election, and the accepted and rejected ballot papers maj be opened and looked into onlj bja a court of lai in connection with the election petition filed in accordance with the existing law.
(3) The Court shall, after the inspection of docments pursuant to Sut-section (2), replace the documents in original ganner and re-seal ther. Ho official or institution other than a court of lai: shall have the authorit; to open such sealec envelopes.
(4) The documents mentioned in this Section shall be preserved for a period of one year either fron the date of final disposal of the suit, if ani; o: froe the date of expir; of linitation period specified for filing of election petition.
37. Orders and pirectives :
(1) : The Comission nay issue necessary orders to carr: out the objectives of this ket.
(2) The Comission may issue necessary Directives to the Returning officer for the concustion of election works.
38. Manual :

The Comission maj frabe hanual on election prosedures and inplenent it.
39. Assistance :

The Retuming officer nay avail the assistance of other erplojees in addition to the employees of the Parliament Secretariat.
40. Jurisdiction Relating to Disputes:

The Election Iribunal constituted under the Election (Offenves and Pumishonent) Let, 2047, shall bave the jurisdiction to try and decide cases under this let.
41. Saving :

Ho question sbail be raised in anj court of law, excepting the flection fribunal constituted under the Election (Offences and Punishent) det, 2047 , in respect of any act relating to election performed in pursuance of the prorisions of this het or the orders issued hereunder.
