LOCAL GOVERNMENT (DISTRICT COUNCILS) (BLANTIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1974

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Local Government (District Councils) Act, I, RICHARD ALLEN BANDA, Minister for Local Government, hereby make the following Order -

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Local

Covernment (District Councils) (Blantyre

1974, and shall come into operation on the

Amendment of paragraph 2 of Cap. 22:02 Sub. leg. Local Govt. Supp. p. B1

- 2. Paragraph 2 of the Local Government
 (District Councils) (<u>Blantyre</u>
 District Council) Order, hereinafter referred
 to as the "principal Order", is amended as
 follows -
 - (a) by deleting therefrom the definition "Nominated Councillor" and substituting therefor the following
 "Nominated Councillor" means any

 Councillor appointed pursuant

 to paragraph 10;"; and
 - (t) by inserting, in proper alphabetical sequence, the following new definitions -

"Chairman" means the person appointed as such by the Regional

Committee pursuant to sub-paragraph (2) of paragraph 8;

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"nominated candidate" means any cerson nominated by celection by the residents of any Area pursuant to paragraph 8 for appointment as a Nominated Councillor pursuant to paragraph 10;

"Regional Committee" means the
Regional Committee of the Malawi
Congress Party for the Region in
which the Blantyre
District is situate;

"resident" in relation to the District, or to any Area thereof, as the case may be, means any person of the age of eighteen years or over who has resided in the District, or in such Area thereof, as the case may be, for a period of not less than twelve bookhas before the date of the felevent meeting by 10 under paragraph 3;"

Replacement of paragraph 5 of the principal Order

3. The principal Order is hereby amended by deleting paragraph 5 and substituting the following new paragraph therefor -

"Composition of Council

- 5. The total number of Councillors shall be twenty-three , of which -
- (a) the number of ex officio

 Councillors to be appointed

 pursuant to paragraph 6 shall.

Provided that, in the event of the creation of any new Area in the District, the total number of Councillors hereinabove provided for the district shall be increased by are Monthable Carnellor, to be numbered pursuant to paragraph 10."

Replacement of paragraphs 7, 8, 9 and 10 of principal Order

4. The principal Order is hereby amended by deleting paragraphs 7, 8, 9 and 10 and substituting the following new paragraphs therefor -

The Minister shall, from "Fixing of date time to time, within two months for selection of before the date of termination nominaof office of Nominated Councilted candidalors under this Order, fix a tes date when a public meeting of the residents of each Area of the District shall be held in each such Area for the purpose of selection of nominated candidates from such Area; and, upon fixing such date, the Minister shall request the Regional

Committee to give notice of, and conduct and control, such public meeting pursuant to paragraph 8:

Provided that the first such public meeting for each such Area shall be held as provided by the proviso to sub-philippingh (1) of the SFIG pathignach 8:

As Lasting of nominated candidates by residents

shall, in such manner as they deem reasonable and appropriate, cause notice to be given in each Area of the date fixed by the Minister for the holding of the public meeting in the said Area for the selection of nominated candidates, of the place within such Area where, and of the time when, such meeting shall be held, and shall convene the same:

- (2) The Regional Serviction shall highlight a Charling, and stable other officers and efficials for each such meeting as they doom necessary for the proper conduct and supervision of such meeting, and shall determine the procedure to be followed.
- (3) Upon declaring the meeting open, the Chairman shall inform those present of any special directions of the Regional Committee as to the conduct of such meeting; and as to the procedure to be followed for selection of nominated candidates and as to the number of nominated candidates to be selected thereat.
- (4) No person shall be eligible for selection as a nominated candidate from any Area unlegs a
- (a) he is a confident of the prid Area; and
- (b) he is a member of the Halawi Congress Party.
- (5) No person, other than a person who is a resident of the Area for which the person is proposed for selection as a nominated candidate, shall be eligible to propose such person for selection, or to second or

- (6) Every person proposed for selection as a nominated candidate shall be proposed and seconded and shall be supported by three persons other than the proposer and seconder.
- (7) No person shall be eligible to take part in such actestical unless he is a resident of the Aros in relation to which such mosting is being held.
- (8) The ruling of the Chairman on any question arising during the meeting shall be final.
- (9) Upon the completion of the selection of nominated candidates, the Chairman shall cause a list to be compiled showing, in order of selection, the names of all of the candidates nominated by the residents of the Area for appointment as Nominated Councillor to represent such Area pursuant to paragraph 10.
- (10) The Chairman shall, without andue delay after the close of the meeting, forward to the Minister a copy of the list referred to in sub-paragraph (9), cortified by him as being
- a true copy thereof.

Minister to dubmit neminations to President

the said certified copy of the list of nominated candidates to the President as being that of the person nominated by the residents of the Area as their candidates for appointment to represent the Area as Nominated Counciller.

Appointment of Nominated Councillors

- 10. -(1) The President may, in his absolute discretion, accept one of the nominations for Nominated Councillor submitted to him pursuant to paragraph 9, and shall appoint as such nominated Councillor such person whose nomination he has accepted.
- deciding not to accept any nomination, under not-paragraph (1), he shall, from manget the residents of the District personally nominate and appoint any person as the Neminated Counciller for such Area.

(2) In the event of the impaident

Terms of office of Councillors 11. Subject to paragraph 12, Councillors appointed as ex officio Councillors under paragraph 6, and as Manineted Councillors under paragraph 10, shall held office for three years from the latement in

the year of their appointment.

Casual vacancies

12. -(1) If, for any reason, any office of a Neminated Councillor shall become vacant before the expiry of his term of office, the Clerk of Cauncil shall, as soon as is practicable thereafter, notify the Einister of such vacancy, who shall advise the Regional Corsulties of the said vacancy, and regitest their tu proceed to selection of nominated candidate to fill such vacancy pursuant to paragraph 8. Whereupon appointment to such vacancy chall be made pursuant to paragraph 10.

(2) Any person appointed under this paragraph shall hold office as Councillor until the expiry of the term of office in respect of which the vacancy arose.

Election of Chairman

13. At the first meeting of the Council, in the month of April in each year, the Councillors present shall elect a Chairman of the Council from among their number. Such Chairman, unless he resigns as such or seases to be a Councillor, minute to held of fice until his successor is elected.

Penors of 14. The Council shall have all Council of the powers set out in the First Schedule to the Act." 5. -(1) The first Councillors appointed under Transitional this Order shall take office on the date of their respective appointments and shall cease to hold office on the 31st March, 1977.
