1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Purpose

The purpose of this Request for Quotation (RFQ) is to invite prospective vendors to submit a written response (“Response”) for the procurement of **Technological Equipment and Biometric Hardware** to a federal government counterpart to establish dedicated registration booths for women in National Registration Centers (NRC) across **Pakistan**. The solicitation provides prospective vendors with the relevant operational and performance requirements.

1.2 Coverage & Participation

IFES reserves the right to reject any and all offers, to add, delete or modify any element of the solicitation at any time without prior notification and without any liability or obligation of any kind. This **RFQ** does not obligate IFES to enter into a contract nor does it obligate IFES to pay any costs incurred in the preparation of submission of any Response.

3.5 5 Criteria for Selection

The evaluation of each Response to this solicitation will be based on the criteria outlined below. The purpose of this solicitation is to identify responsible, prospective vendors that have the interest, capability, and financial strength to supply IFES with the product and/or service identified in the Scope of Work.

Evaluation Criteria:

IFES will evaluate bids based on the following criteria:

1. **TIMELINE** **25 points**
IFES expects the goods/services to be delivered by end of September 2021.

2. **EXPERIENCE** **25 points**
IFES expects the vendor to have a solid number of years of experience providing similar scale/service of requested goods.

3. **QUALITY** **25 points**
IFES expects the quality and specifications of the technological equipment and biometric devices provided to be exactly as noted under the scope.

4. **PRICE** **25 points**
IFES expects the price to be cost effective and reasonable per current market rates.

3.6 6 Selection and Notification

IFES will evaluate Responses to identify responsible vendors and responsive offers. Finalists will be selected to move into the negotiation phase of this process. Written notification will be sent to finalists via email.

4 SCOPE OF WORK/GOODS/SERVICES

A government counterpart has requested support from implementing partners to provide technological materials needed to establish women exclusive registration booths in National Registration Centers (NRCs) across the Pakistan. IFES, with support from Global Affairs Canada, seeks qualified vendors to provide the following materials for 75 booths. Note that vendors may respond to part or all of the below solicitation.

5 FUNCTIONAL REQUIREMENTS

5.1 1 Timeline

Prospective vendors must submit a timeline in the Response showing the time required to produce and consolidate the products and/or deliver services.

5.2 Pakistan License, Clearance and Approvals

The prospective vendors will include in the timeline any time needed to obtain any licenses, clearances, and/or approvals required under local legal requirements to produce or deliver the products and/or services described in the Scope of Work.

5.3 Packing

The Response must contain details of packing for each product that requires shipping with full dimensions (length, width, and height) and weight.

5.4 4 Shipping

Prospective vendors must arrange for shipping and delivery to locations specified at a later stage of the award. These will be across Pakistan and cost will have to be accounted for in the initial contract. No additional shipping, handling and delivery costs will be allowable. The selected vendor is responsible for covering customs charges, if any, and these must be reflected in the proposal.

5.5 5 Samples

Samples of the various technological devices will be inspected according to the provided specifications. If the delivered equipment is not according to the specs, the samples will be rejected at vendor cost.

6 QUALIFICATIONS & REFERENCES

Prospective vendors must provide the following information for their Response to be considered:

1. A brief outline of the company and services offered, including:
 - Full legal name and address of the company
 - Corporate and tax registration documents
 - Year business was started or established
 - Full name of the legal representative (president or managing director) of the company
 - Name of any individuals or entities that own 50% or more of the company
2. Evidence of successful completion of a project of a similar size and complexity.
3. References: Contact information for no less than three references from projects similar in size, application, and scope and a brief description of their implementation (including location and year). IFES reserves the right to request and check additional references.
4. Prospective vendors must be legally registered under the laws of the country in which they are organized and possess all licenses, permits and government approvals necessary for performance of the work. Scope of Work.

7 PRICING

Prospective contractors must complete the following cost breakdown for the implementation of their solution for IFES' project as described in this solicitation. Prospective contractors must agree to keep these prices valid for a minimum of **90 calendar days**.

Pricing must be in **Pakistani rupee (PKR)**. Unit prices are required and in the case of discrepancies between unit prices and the total price, the unit price will be taken as reference basis in the evaluation. Technical specifications must be shown for each item.

While one single vendor does not need to provide all six hardwares, preference will be given to vendors who can deliver all components.

8.1 1 Non-Disclosure Agreement

IFES reserves the right to require the prospective vendor to enter into a non-disclosure agreement.

8.2 2 No Collusion

Collusion is strictly prohibited. Collusion is defined as an agreement or compact, written or oral, between two or more parties with the goal of limiting fair and open competition by deceiving, misleading, or defrauding a third party.

8.3 3 Companies Owned or Controlled by Government

The prospective vendor must disclose in writing with its Response if a government, its agents, or agencies, have an ownership or managerial interest in the company. Failure to disclose a government ownership of managerial interest in the company will result in the prospective contractor's offer being removed from consideration.

8.4 4 Subcontracting

The prospective contractor must disclose in writing with its Response any subcontracting that will take place under an award. Failure to disclose subcontracting relationships will result in the prospective contractor's offer being removed from consideration. (if permitted by the solicitation)

8.5 5 Costs

The solicitation does not obligate IFES to pay for any costs, of any kind whatsoever, which may be incurred by a prospective contractor/vendor or third parties, in connection with the Response.

8.6 6 Intellectual Property

Prospective vendors may **not** use any intellectual property of IFES including, but not limited to, all logos, trademarks, or trade names of IFES, at any time without the prior written approval of IFES.

8.7 Prospective Contractors' Responses

All accepted Responses shall become the property of IFES and will not be returned.

8.8 Partial Awarding

IFES reserves the right to accept all or part of the Response when awarding a contract.

8.9 9 No Liability

IFES reserves the right to accept or reject any Response or to stop the procurement process at any time, without assigning any reason or liability. IFES shall not be liable to any prospective contractor, person, or entity for any losses, expenses, costs, claims, or damages of any kind.

8.10 Entire Solicitation

This solicitation, any addenda to it, and any attached schedules, constitute the entire solicitation.

Contractor will not in connection with this solicitation or contract use, procure or obtain any video surveillance or telecommunication equipment produced by Hytera Communications Corporation, Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Company, or Dahua Technology Company (or any subsidiary or affiliate of such entities).

C. Contractor will not in connection with this solicitation or contract use, procure or obtain any telecommunication or video surveillance services provided by the entities named in Section 4(A) or Section 4(B) of this Certification or using the equipment identified in Section 4(A) or Section 4(B) of this Certification.

5. Contractor acknowledges and agrees that IFES intends to rely upon the foregoing certifications in potentially obligating or expending U.S. government funds to or for the benefit of Contractor. To the extent that any of the foregoing certifications is untrue, inaccurate, incomplete or misleading, Contractor will indemnify, defend and hold IFES harmless from and against all claims, damages, liabilities, or losses,

including all expenses and actual attorneys' fees, arising directly or indirectly from or in connection with the inaccuracy of any of Contractor's certifications.
